On 6 October 2023, Ginger signed an agreement to acquire Caraïbes Environnement Développement, based in Baie-Mahault, Guadeloupe.

Caraïbes Environnement Développement is an environmental and sustainable development consultancy and engineering firm that has been operating in Guadeloupe for almost 30 years. The company now relies on the skills of a team of around ten employees. It is involved in numerous projects for customers in both the public and private sectors.
